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Share your views about Grenfell Tower and the future memorial

As the owner of the Grenfell Tower site, the government wants to engage with bereaved family members, survivors, local residents and the North Kensington community, on decisions and activity relating to the Tower.

A decision has not yet been made about what will happen to the Tower. We don't underestimate how difficult this decision will be, particularly for bereaved families. **We want to hear your views before a decision is made, and to ensure you are supported to have your say.**

The independent Grenfell Tower Memorial Commission also wants to speak to and hear from you, and to work together in developing a fitting way to remember those who lost their lives in the Grenfell tragedy. The Memorial Commission wrote to you in December to share the ideas it has heard so far for the future memorial and to explain how you can give your ideas on that. **I am now also writing to tell you how you can have your say in upcoming decisions about Grenfell Tower.**

Since September a community engagement specialist, Kaizen, has been carrying out these discussions about both the Tower and the memorial with the bereaved, former residents and the community. **You can share your views with them however it suits you best. Kaizen can offer conversations in a range of languages if that would be helpful.**

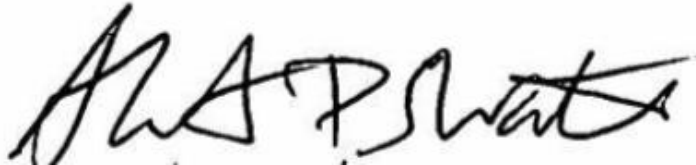
These discussions are still in their early stages and it is important that they include the crucial voices we wish to hear from, in particular, bereaved families and survivors. Decisions on both the Tower and memorial are likely to take several years to implement, hence why we need to start these discussions now.

I want to reassure you that the government is in regular contact with the police and the Grenfell Tower Inquiry to ensure that decisions about the Tower site do not interfere with their work.
