## **Enforcement action taken in the period: 1 April 2018 to 30 September 2018**

The Office for Product Safety and Standards was created in January 2018 by the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, to enhance protections for consumers and the environment and drive increased productivity, growth and business confidence.

The Office takes forward the work of the previous Regulatory Delivery directorate, including its enforcement responsibilities. The enforcement actions listed below were taken by the Office in 2018.

### **May 2018**

#### **Company:**

#### **Furlong Flooring (Southern) Limited**

#### **Action taken:**

Notice of Remedial Actions, issued on 30 May 2018 under Regulation 11 of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013.

#### **Product:**

A shipment of hardwood flooring

#### **Breached regulation details:**

Regulation 4(b) of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013

#### **Detail:**

Furlong Flooring (Southern) Limited. failed to implement measures to ensure the timber used had been legally harvested.

The Office for Product Safety and Standards subsequently received written confirmation from Furlong Flooring (Southern) Limited that it is now meeting the obligations of an operator.

## **June 2018**

**Company:**

**SWI (UK) B.V.**

**Action taken:**

Notice of Remedial Actions, issued on 17 June 2018 under Regulation 11 of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013.

**Product:**

A shipment of hardwood flooring.

**Breached regulation details:**

Regulation 4(b) of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013

**Detail:**

SWI (UK) B.V. failed to implement measures to ensure the timber used had been legally harvested.

The Office for Product Safety and Standards subsequently received written confirmation from SWI (UK) B.V. that it is now meeting the obligations of an operator.

## **August 2018**

**Company:**

**Lloyd Pascal & Co. Limited**

**Action taken:**

Notice of Remedial Actions, issued on 13 August 2018 under Regulation 11 of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013.

**Product:**

A shipment of wooden furniture.

**Breached regulation details:**

Regulation 4(b) of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013

**Detail:**

Lloyd Pascal & Co. Limited failed to implement measures to ensure the timber used had been legally harvested.

The Office for Product Safety and Standards subsequently received written confirmation from Lloyd Pascal & Co. Limited that it is now meeting the obligations of an operator.

**Company:**

**Papaya Trading Limited**

**Action taken:**

Notice of Remedial Actions, issued on 14 August 2018 under Regulation 11 of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013.

**Product:**

Oak bookcase

**Breached regulation details:**

Regulation 4(b) of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013

**Detail:**

Papaya Trading Limited failed to implement measures to ensure the timber used had been legally harvested.

The Office for Product Safety and Standards subsequently received written confirmation from Papaya Trading Limited that it is now meeting the obligations of an operator.
