Enforcement Action taken in the period: 1 October 2019 to 31 March 2020

The Office for Product Safety and Standards (OPSS) is part of the Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy. We oversee the regulatory system for product safety and standards in the UK. Our purpose is to make regulation work, so that it protects people and enables businesses to understand their obligations. The statutory enforcement actions listed below were taken by OPSS in 1 October 2019 to 31 March 2020.

Action taken:

Notice of Remedial Actions, issued on 5th December 2019 under Regulation 11 of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013

Product:

Chester Grey TV Stand (commodity code 94036010)

Breached regulation details:

Regulation 4(b) of the Timber and Timber Products (Placing on the Market) Regulations 2013.

Detail:

The Cotswold Company (UK) Ltd failed to implement measures to ensure the timber used had been legally harvested.

OPSS subsequently received written confirmation from the Cotswold Company (UK) Ltd that it is now meeting the obligations of an operator.
