GRANT DETERMINATION 2020/21: Skills Advisory Panels: Increasing analytical capability and building influence

(No 31/5071 and DfE reference 4709)

The Secretary of State for Education, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, makes the following determination:

Citation

1) This determination may be cited as the “Skills Advisory Panels: Increasing analytical capability and building influence” Grant Determination 2020/21 (No31/5071).

Purpose of the grant

2) The purpose of the grant is to provide support to Local Authorities in England towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

3) The Secretary of State for Education determines the Authorities to which the Grant is to be paid and the amount of Grant to be paid; these are set out in Annex A.

Payment of Grant

4) The Grants shall be payable to Local Authorities in one instalment no earlier than 30 June 2020 for 2020/2021.

Treasury consent

5) Before making this determination in relation to Local Authorities in England, the Minister of State obtained the consent of the Treasury.
