Converter Academy Orders

- 1A Whether to approve Mount Church of England Primary and Nursery School, **Nottinghamshire**, to convert and join Diocese of Southwell and Nottingham Multi Academy Trust.

Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Region

Significant Change

- 2A Whether The Market Bosworth School, **Leicestershire**, should be allowed a physical expansion of premises by adding a new classroom block, in order to increase capacity from 672 to 860, and increase its PAN from 152 to 172.

York, East Riding, Hull & North East Lincolnshire Region

Significant Change

- 3A Whether Ings Primary School, **Kingston Upon Hull**, should be allowed the creation of a 10 place Social, Emotional and Mental Health unit

Derby and Derbyshire Region

Significant Change

- 4A Whether Ashcroft Primary Academy, **Derby**, should be allowed to lower the age range from 5 - 11 year olds to 3 - 11 year olds in order to facilitate the addition of a 26 place nursery.
