








### South West age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 8 Mar to 31 Mar 2021


















#### Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole: 8 Mar to 4 Apr 2021














#### Exeter case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 4 Apr 2021


### Forest of Dean case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 4 **Apr 2021**


























#### Stroud case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 4 Apr 2021








#### Torbay case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 4 Apr 2021






