## FOOTBALL-RELATED ARRESTS AND BANNING ORDERS SEASON 2009-10

### Statistical Highlights

Total attendance in excess of 39 million at regulated football matches (37 million in England and Wales). The total number of arrests represents less than 0.01% of all spectators.

During the 2009-10 season the total number of people arrested in connection with all international and domestic football matches involving teams from England and Wales was 3,391. This represents a decrease of 10%, or 395 arrests. The downwards trend in football-related arrests is continuing, but there is no complacency.

This covers all arrests designated in law under schedule 1 of the Football Spectators Act 1989 (as amended) reported by police to the Football Banning Orders Authority. This includes football specific offences (e.g. throwing missiles in a stadium, pitch encroachment) and a wide range of generic criminal offences committed in connection with a football match. This is any arrest at any place within a period of 24 hours either side of a match.

During the season an average of 1.05 arrests were made per match (inside and outside of stadia).

No arrests at 70% of all matches. Two arrests or less were made at 85% of matches.

47% of all matches were police free – continuing to free up police resources to deal with local police and community priorities.

More than 90,000 English and Welsh club fans travelled to Champions League and Europa League matches outside of England and Wales. These 42 matches resulted in just 12 arrests.

No football-related arrests of England or Wales supporters at overseas matches, including the 2010 World Cup in South Africa.

The number of football banning orders increased slightly to 3,248 on 19<sup>th</sup> November 2010 from 3,180 on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2009. This represents 1,025 new banning orders imposed during the period. Orders are time limited and expiring all the time.

Banning orders work – since 2000 in the region of 92% of individuals whose orders have expired are assessed by police as no longer posing a risk of football disorder.

## STATISTICS ON FOOTBALL-RELATED ARRESTS & BANNING ORDERS 2009-10 SEASON

During the football season police Football Intelligence Officers submit a range of data, including arrest information, to the Football Banning Orders Authority (FBOA). FBOA also administer all football banning orders. Home Office collate and publish football-related arrest and banning order data annually.
