



## Voluntary Poultry Registration Form - Keeper of Fewer Than 50 Birds

Use this form if you have **fewer than 50 birds** even if you keep them as pets. If you keep 50 birds or more, you must complete the Compulsory Poultry Registration Form - Keeper of 50 or More Birds (IRA81). You are breaking the law if you do not register 50 or more birds.

In completing this form you agree to APHA contacting you in the event of disease outbreaks (such as Avian Influenza (bird flu)) in your area. You also agree to APHA giving you advice and information on biosecurity and animal disease control. Your details may be shared with other government departments in relation to animal disease control.

Complete this form if you are in charge of the day-to-day care of the poultry (**the keeper**). Complete all fields marked with an \* or add 'N/A'. Contact the free Poultry Registration Helpline on **0800 634 1112** for help with completing the form.
