**Gatso Type 24 Radar - Trailer mounted fixed installation systems**

Both Dr. Steve Lewis and the Secretariat are confident if the guidelines laid out in the report of [redacted] are applied, these trailer mounted systems can be used for enforcement purposes and the force which has been using the device over the last few months has done so within the spirit of those guidelines.
