Reason for change (including benefits)

In May 2019, the Government announced it would return to referring to fixed term exclusion as 'suspension' and permanent exclusion as 'expulsion', to prevent confusion and conflation between the two terms.

The Department will no longer use the term 'exclusion' and will refer to expulsion and suspension going forward. Departmental publications will be updated accordingly when due for review.
