Reason for change (including benefits)

Identifying Early Career Teachers (ECTs) in their second year of induction will be critical to ensure funding is provided to schools to fund second-year ECTs' 5% timetable reduction and their mentor pairing.

To allocate funding, we need to know the number of second year ECTs (as distinct from first year ECTs) in each school.

This new item will apply in the School Workforce census from November 2021

Impact of not doing the change

The Early Career Framework (ECF) commits DfE to reforming induction for ECTs. The revised offer for ECTs includes:

• 2 years of new, funded, high-quality training;

- Making freely available high-quality development materials based on the ECF;
- Additional funding for time away from the classroom for teachers in their second year (dependent on this data collection amendment);
- A dedicated mentor and new training for these mentors;
- Funding to cover mentors' time with mentee in second year of training (dependent on this data collection amendment).

This data item is needed to ensure that the funding can be directed to schools, without it we wil not be able to meet the commitments made by ministers and enshrined in legislation.

Software suppliers' summary of impact assessment

Suppliers were supportive of this new data item and no issues implanting as specified.

One supplier commented the following which will be addressed when reviewing guidance and supporting validation: *My only comment is that the DfE should add that NQT1 or NQT2 is only acceptable where QT (Qualified Teacher) Status is true. Which means that 'NotNQT' must always be applied when QT Status is false, even if QTLS (Qualified Teacher of Learning and Skills) Status is true and/or EYT (Early Years Teacher) Status is true.*
