North Sub-Region

Trust Change

Project: Whether to give in-principle approval for the transfer of five Sharnbrook Academy Federation's (SAF) academies, Bedford, to Cambridge Meridian Academies Trust (CMAT).

HTB discussion:

- HTB members discussed performance results of the SAF academies.
- HTB members discussed the finances of both SAF and CMAT.
- HTB members discussed the governance structure and capacity at CMAT.
