Items for discussion in this meeting

Cambridgeshire

Significant Changes

- Whether Eastern Learning Alliance should be allowed to increase the age range from 11-16 to 11-19 and add a sixth form provision in Chesterton Community College, **Cambridge**.
- Whether The Cam Academy Trust should be allowed to increase the age range from 11-16 to 11-19, add a sixth form provision and increase the physical capacity from 1250 to 1650 in Cambourne Village College, **South Cambridgeshire**.

Essex

Significant Changes

- Whether Academies Enterprise Trust should be allowed to increase the number of school places from 125 to 170 in The Pioneer School, **Basildon** and from 227 to 270 in Columbus School and College, **Chelmsford**.
- Whether Ormiston Academies Trust should be allowed to increase the PAN from 180 to 210 and expand the building in Ormiston Rivers Academy, **Maldon**.

- Whether Orwell Multi Academy Trust should be allowed to increase the number of school places from 210 to 315 in Brooklands Primary School, **Babergh**.
