

**Consent to certain actions for the purposes of the Initial Enforcement Order made by the Competition and Markets Authority ('CMA') on 7 August 2014**

**Completed acquisition by Enterprise Rent-A-Car UK Limited ('Enterprise') of Burnt Tree Holdings Limited ('Target')**

We refer to your emails dated 19 August 2014 and 22 August 2014 requesting that the CMA consents to derogations to the Initial Enforcement Order of 7 August 2014 (the 'Initial Order').

Under the Initial Order, save for written consent by the CMA, provision was made that Enterprise will hold separate the Enterprise business (as defined in the Initial Order) from the Target's business. After due consideration of your request for a derogation to the Initial Order, Enterprise may carry out the following actions, in respect of the specific paragraphs:

**Paragraphs 5(a) and 5(g) of the Initial Order**

During the specified period (as defined in the Initial Order), [X] (Enterprise Vehicle Acquisitions) is authorized to negotiate with vehicle manufacturers for the purchase of vehicles required by Burnt Tree. Any vehicle requirements will be identified by Burnt Tree's existing management without the involvement of any Enterprise personnel and [X] will only be provided with aggregated information on the volume and type of vehicles required. Such information will not include information relating to the customers to which the vehicles relate or the delivery locations of those vehicles. [X] will keep any information provided to him by Burnt Tree confidential and will not discuss with any other Enterprise personnel.
