The pilot was landing on Runway 03 at Shoreham, which had a published landing distance of 871 metres. Its asphalt surface was dry and the PAPIs, set to 3.5° , were serviceable. The reported surface wind was $350^{\circ}/10$ kt with good visibility and no significant weather.

The pilot reported that he was established on the runway centre line and glide path and at the correct speed. On touchdown however the aircraft bounced. The pilot briefly applied full power and then attempted a further landing during which the nose wheel collapsed and the propeller struck the runway surface. The pilot and his passenger, who were wearing lap and diagonal seat belts, vacated the aircraft without injury.
