The aircraft was in the final stages of loading for a scheduledservice to Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. A conveyor type loading vehiclelurched backwards and to one side while being reversed. The endof the loading ramp caused a four inch gash in the side frameof the aft bulk cargo hold door.

The aircraft was withdrawn from service for repair after inspection by airline engineering staff.
