The pilot reports that whilst he was carrying out circuit practice he completed a normal approach for a crosswind landing on runway 04. After touch down, and before the flaps were raised the aircraft swung to the left and slid sideways for a short distance, before it stopped facing back down the runway. The aircraft was moved under its own power clear of the runway where an inspection revealed minor damage to the right main landing gear. The surface wind was 350°/15 knots.
