The aircraft was parked on Stand 1 at Edinburgh Airport; it was raining heavily. In order to position his 'Cargo King' baggageloading vehicle at the forward hold, the driver had to apply fullleft steering lock. When loading was complete and he started reverse away from the hold the left lock was still applied and the front right side of the vehicle struck the front edge of the front hold door frame.

The passengers, cargo and baggage were transferred to later flightsand the aircraft was ferried to East Midlands Airport for repair.
