The handling pilot, who had a total of 263 flying hours, had not previously flown the Rallye. While landing into a 15 kt headwind, the aircraft dropped the last 15 feet onto the runway causing damage to the right landing gear. The pilot in command attributed the cause of the accident to the inexperience on type of the handling pilot together with the presence of wind shear.
