The student pilot had carried out 1 hour and 45 minutes of circuitflying with a break, after 40 minutes, for refuelling. On completion of the final circuit the aircraft bounced on landing. The pilotattempted to rectify this by pulling back on the control column but at a low airspeed he was unable to prevent the aircraft landingheavily on the nosewheel and damaging the propeller.
