The instructor, in the left seat, was teaching take offs and landingsto a student who had completed 9 hours of flying training. The weather was good with a surface wind of 050°/7 kt. Followinga demonstration by the instructor, the student made a landingand initial ground contact was on the left skid. With this skidon the ground, the aircraft started drifting to the left and theinstructor lowered the collective. However, almost immediately, as the right skid touched the ground, the student raised the collective and the aircraft rolled rapidly to the left; the main rotor bladesstruck the ground and GWIGL rolled over.
