After an apparently normal 20 flap approach on Runway 21, with a wind given as 250°/10 kt, the aircraft bounced after initial touchdown. The pilot reported that he then pushed the stick forward to put the aircraft back onto the ground. The subsequent touchdown was on the nosewheel. After vacating at the end of the runway, the pilot experienced some difficulty taxiing the aircraft, and stopped on the taxiway to prevent further damage.
