The aircraft was on final approach to Runway 09; the surface windwas 080°/5 kt and the visibility was good. The ground risesto the west of the airfield and a single cable 11kV power linecrosses the approach approximately at right angles to it. Theaircraft wheels struck the power line and it pitched forward and struck the ground a short distance ahead. Both occupants sustainedserious injury.

It was estimated that the power line was about 600 metres fromand about 30 metres above the touchdown point. Neither the pilotnor his passenger, also a pilot, saw the power line which blendedinto the background.
