The aircraft was landing on Runway 27, a dry grass runway. The surface wind was 240°/10 kt, giving a crosswind component of 5 kt. During the touchdown there was some drift to the right and the right hand main landing gear collapsed. The aircraft veered to the right and then turned to the left coming to rest off the left side of the runway. The pilot and passengers were all able to exit normally through the aircraft door.
