The aircraft was on a pleasure flight from Ostend to Lydd in CAVOKweather conditions. Having joined the visual circuit for Runway22 the pilot called downwind and was distracted from his prelandingchecks whilst looking for other circuit traffic. The aircraftlanded with the wheels retracted and came to rest on the runway. The pilot and passenger vacated the aircraft uninjured.

The ATC controller, who had been watching the aircraft duringthe final stages of its approach, did not notice the absence of the landing gear because of the aircraft's nose down attitude and his attention was focused on a preceding aircraft as it cleared the runway.
