The aircraft was landing back at Stapleford aerodrome following a short cross country flight. There was a light breeze blowing from 20° to the left of the runway heading. After touch down the pilot was unable to prevent a swing to the right and, as the aircraft ran off the prepared surface of the runway, it tipped onto its nose and left wing tip.
