The aircraft was taking off from a farmer's field. Immediately after the aircraft became airborne, it experienced a severe swing to the right and the starboard wing touched the ground. The aircraft then cartwheeled before coming to rest, with the engine detached and the wings and fuselage damaged.

Examination of the aircraft has not revealed any mechanical or structural defects which could have caused the accident.
