After an uneventful flight from Popham the pilot made an approach to grass Runway 26 at Compton Abbas Airfield, the aircraft ballooned in the flare to land and a go-around was executed. The aircraft bounced on touchdown from the second approach and the pilot initiated another go-around. At an early stage of the downwind leg for his next approach, the engine stopped and a wheels up forced landing was made into a grass field. Subsequent inspection of the fuel tanks showed them to be completely dry and examination of the aircraft revealed the fuel drain cap and spring mechanism to be missing. A search was carried out at Compton Abbas and at the forced landing field but the items were not located. The pilot and one of his passengers both recall the fuel drain being in place during the pre-flight walk round checks.
