The aircraft was making an approach to land on Runway 09 after a short local flight. Approaching the runway threshold, the pilot noted that the landing gear was not down. He selected the landing gear down but underestimated the time taken to complete the deployment cycle. The aircraft touched down before the landing gear was locked down and the aircraft settled onto its lower fuselage before coming to a halt on the runway.

The attending Airfield Fire Service reported that there was fuel leakage from the aircraft and that the left side door had jammed, necessitating the pilot to vacate the aircraft via the right side passenger door.
