After 15 minutes dual flying, the instructor left the aircraft to let the student carry out some solo circuits. The weather was good with a light and variable surface wind.

As the helicopter lifted, it began to yaw to the left. With the skids still in contact with the ground, this turn continued for approximately 360°. The helicopter then lifted about two feet into the air and rolled onto its right side. Debris from the helicopter hit the instructor, who was standing some distance away.
