The aircraft was approaching to land with a slight crosswind component from the left. The pilot reported that he was both high and slow on the round-out and control response was sluggish. A gust of wind blew the

aircraft off the centreline and it stalled at a height of about 3 ft. The aircraft struck the ground nose first and another gust blew it over inverted. Neither the pilot nor his passenger was injured.
