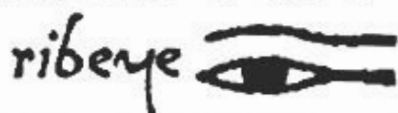

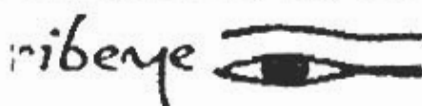

Formula for determining maximum power rating

EN ISO 6185 –3 Determination of maximum motor power:

The maximum motor power is determined by the following formula:

$$P_{\max} = 10 \times F(d) - 33$$

Where:

$P_{\max}$  is the maximum motor power rating in kilowatts

$F(d)$  is the dimensional factor =  $l \times b$

Where:

$l$  is the overall length of the boat in metres, from the bow to the extremity of the rear float;

$b$  is the overall beam of the boat in metres.

### A glorious beach for all the family

**Please abide by the following rules for a safe and enjoyable day**

#### Sea Activities:

\* Launch your boat / personal watercraft in the designated area and keep to the 4-knot speed restriction

\* Please navigate all power driven vessels safely and responsibly

\* All personal watercraft must be registered with Gwynedd Council before launching. You should provide evidence of third party insurance

\* You must pay a launching fee before you can launch from the beach

\* Be vigilant of approaching craft whilst bathing

\* Take care with inflatable beds or toys in the water as currents and winds can take you out to sea

#### On the Beach:

\* Keep within the 5 m.p.h. speed limit on the beach

\* Be vigilant of manoeuvring vehicles when walking along the slipway or beach

\* Do not take your dog into the dog restriction areas, nor let your dog run free to foul the beach - dog-fouling bags are available from the Beach Supervisors

\* Children need to be supervised by an adult at all times, especially near the sea

\* Don't swim after eating or drinking alcohol, or if you are feeling tired or unwell

\* If you see someone in difficulty dial 999 immediately and ask for the Coastguard, and then contact one of the Beach Supervisors

\* For the treatment of minor injuries please ask one of the Beach Supervisors for assistance

**You must comply with the regulations outlined in this leaflet and conform with all instructions given by the Beach Supervisors for your own and others' safety.**

Local regulations for the use of power driven vessels



## **Power Vessel Regulation for Gwynedd Harbours and Coast**

1. Power driven vessels launching on the coast of Gwynedd should provide evidence of third party insurance to a minimum of £1,000,000.
2. The 4 Knots speed limit extends to all areas within all harbours, and within 100 metres of the coastline.
3. Power driver vessels are prohibited from entering any beach safety zone unless using a designated launch area at the specified speed limit.
4. Water skiing without and independent observer will not be permitted.
5. Towing "Doughnut" or "Banana" inflatables is not permitted within harbour areas, craft exclusion zones, or within 100 metres of the coastline. A minimum of two people shall be on board the towing vessel at all times.
6. Launching Fees will be payable at all launching areas.
7. International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea must be strictly adhere to at all times, please ask at the Harbour Office if you are unsure of these regulations.
8. Vehicles are brought onto the launching areas at the owners risk and the requirements and directions of Gwynedd Council officers must be adhered to at all times.
9. A wakeless speed is required within 50 metres of another boat, personal watercraft, dock, pier, swimmer, skier, angler or fishing equipment.
10. Gwynedd Council speed limits must be complied within designated areas.
11. Where there is no specified speed limit the maximum speed is 4 m.p.h within 100 metres of the coastline (from the low water mark).
12. Boating under the influence of drink or drugs shall not be allowed.
13. Navigation of power driven vessels in a responsible manner and with due regard to good seamanship is encouraged.
14. Navigators of powercraft shall not disturb wildlife, especially Dolphins and Porpoises. Please note that it is a criminal offence to disturb wildlife within the Special Area of Conservation
15. Owner / users launching permit will be withdrawn with immediate effect if the navigator of the craft fails to comply with the above conditions.

Special conditions apply at each location and may change each season. Advice from the Harbourmaster must be sought before launching.



Local regulations for the use of PWCs

## Cyngor Gwynedd Council

### Maritime Service

1. Every Personal Watercraft user that uses / crosses Gwynedd Council owned, or managed coastal areas, shall register the craft with Gwynedd Council.
  - 1.1 To obtain registration, a fee shall be paid, and the registering Officer will ensure Proof of Identity, together with proof of adequate insurance cover.
  - 1.2 Access for Personal Watercraft will not be allowed to any of the Councils harbours or beaches if the owner has not registered the craft with Gwynedd Council, or if the registration has been withdrawn. The 'Datatag' identification number must be visible in **bold** lettering, on **both** sides of the craft. **Outline numbers will not be accepted**
2. Minimum Insurance Cover will be Third Party £2 million.
3. Age Requirements:
  - 3.1 Must be at least 18 years of age to operate a Personal Watercraft.
  - 3.2 Be 15 to 17, and possess a R.Y.A. Certificate of Competence for Personal Watercraft. The RYA certificate must be available for inspection at all times.
  - 3.3 Be 12 to 14, and possess a R.Y.A. Certificate of Competence **AND** operate under direct adult supervision. The definition of "supervision" is such that the adult is present **on the craft**. The RYA certificate must be available for inspection at all times.
  - 3.4 Under 12 - not allowed to operate a Personal Watercraft.
4. Speed Restrictions:
  - 4.1 A wakeless speed is compulsory within **50 metres** of another Personal Watercraft, boat, dock, swimmer, skier, angler, or fishing equipment.
  - 4.2 Gwynedd Council speed restrictions must be complied with in all designated areas. Power craft are not permitted within exclusion zones.
  - 4.3 Where there is no specified speed limit, the maximum speed is 4 m.p.h. within 100 metres of the coastline (from the low water mark).
5. Boating under the influence of drink, or drugs is not permitted.
6. It is an offence to disturb wildlife. Navigators of Personal Watercraft shall not disturb Dolphins, Porpoises, Basking Sharks or other wildlife.
7. Launching fees will be payable at all locations.
8. The owner/users registration will be withdrawn immediately if the operator fails to comply with the above conditions.
