

## RETAIL BANKING MARKET INVESTIGATION

### Revised GfK data tables

**24 September 2015**

Please note that we have today published a further [revised set of data tabulations](#).

These changes are as follows:

- Definitions of the break variables under the heading “Used overdraft - last 12 months” have been amended. The new definitions are:
 

Authorised only	G2='1' and G4='1' and G6=0
Unauthorised only	G2='2' and G4='1' and G6>=1
Authorised and unauthorised	G6>=1
Any type of overdraft (authorised or unauthorised)	G4='1'
None	G4='2'
- The break “overdraft but not used” has been removed (we found it potentially confusing under the heading “Used overdraft – last 12 months” heading)
- Information about the base for question F6 has been corrected (it is “All who have changed their main current account in the last three years” now)

The above changes affect a small proportion of figures in the data tabulations (only the results for the sub-groups of customers defined by the break variables: ‘unauthorised only’ and ‘authorised and unauthorised’ have changed). The affected figures had not been quoted in the written report of findings therefore the report has not been amended.

Please note that we have published a revised set of data tabulations.

The version published previously was subject to a small error associated with an incorrect application of weights. A small proportion of survey respondents (28 out of 4,549) were assigned to an incorrect stratum and, as a result, given an incorrect weight. Given the very small proportion of respondents affected, any differences

between the original and the revised sets of results are minor (+/- one percentage point).

For this reason we have not amended the written report of findings.
