

Online Water for Development Yellow Pages

Introduction

SPLASH aims to facilitate coordination between existing water for development research programmes to minimize duplication and identify gaps. It also aims to improve knowledge sharing between researchers and practitioners to speed up the transfer of research findings into policy and practice. The Water for Development Yellow Pages contribute to both these aims, as an information tool providing easy access to water for development research resources.



The purpose

There are a huge number of water for development research projects and programmes that are carried out by different institutions and funded by different donor organizations, as well as a plethora of existing repositories and portals containing information relating to these. The Yellow Pages provide information about online resources for water for development provided by each of the SPLASH partner countries.

The Yellow Pages is useful for those working in the sector as researchers, governments, NGOs, the private sector, funding agencies and decision makers, within both the EU Member States and the Developing Country regions targeted by the SPLASH project. However, it is anticipated that this will also be of interest and relevance to other European and Developing Countries, not covered by the SPLASH programme.

- Online resources are provided for the SPLASH partner countries of Austria, Belgium, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Norway, Switzerland and the UK
- More than 400 resource items are listed in the database
- The Yellow Pages are searchable:
 - by SPLASH partner country
 - by theme (water for people, water for food, water for nature, water for industry/energy, cross cutting issues and other)
 - by information category (electronic discussion lists, information portals and repositories, research funders, research projects and programmes, and university and research institutes)
- The database will be updated on a regular basis and may be extended to include other countries.
