The term 'institution' refers to a body of organizations, regulations, customs and policies.



Examples

- Institutions vs. organizations
- Formal vs. informal
- Paper vs actual
- Design vs. real
- The institution of:
 - Public health
 - Infectious disease surveillance and control
 - Veterinary medicine
 - Household poultry
 - Poultry markets



Never has so much money been invested on such a small evidence base.

CORALLARY: Never has so much money been invested in animal health with so little strategic thinking about institutional impacts.

A wasted opportunity?

- Emergencies interventions vs. developmental relief
 - Emergency interventions (saving lives or averting disaster) often negatively impact institutions and increase long term vulnerability
 - Developmental approaches build institutions and often can be used to reach the same goals
 - Medium term approaches
 - Developmental mitigation?
 - International public good?
 - Lesson of rinderpest.

- Explicitly define institutional objectives.
- How do we transform the slaughter location at left?

Experiments

- Specific interventions to address critical control points identified by risk analysis
- Selective things that can be validated on a micro scale
- Measure epidemiological impact through estimates of indicators
- Document institutional impacts and untoward effects
