

IAVI in Europe

IAVI's Amsterdam office oversees the extensive European programme. The organization also has a liaison office in Brussels and a clinical laboratory in London. Activities include AIDS vaccine research and development, securing and managing financial and political support, and mobilizing communities. In Europe, IAVI has partnered with academic institutions, biotechnology firms and pharmaceutical companies to implement five vaccine development projects and conduct early-phase clinical trials of AIDS vaccine candidates in the United Kingdom, Belgium, Germany and Switzerland. Furthermore, IAVI has secured funding from seven European governments and the European Union, and established an advocacy voice across Europe through a network of civil society organizations.
