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Abstract

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- 19 Stocking initiatives have become an increasingly popular intervention in inland rural
- 20 fisheries development, and stocking has been a high priority on inland fisheries
- 21 development agendas over the past two decades. However, experiences of stocking
- ventures have shown that whilst stocking has the potential to yield substantial benefits,
- the actual outcomes (in terms of for example, yields, benefit distribution and institutional
- 24 sustainability), are often different from those initially expected. One reason for this is the
- 25 complexity of the environments into which enhancements are introduced, involving
- 26 dynamic interactions between the biological characteristics of the resource, the technical
- intervention of enhancement and, crucially, the people who utilise or manage it.

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
