

Getting Started

- Conduct a rapid assessment
- Identify broad objectives and possibilities
- Raise awareness and develop support



Developing the Plan

- Existing drainage facilities
- Water reuse practices
- Who does what ? – Institutions
- What is allowed ? – Legislation
- Health – what information is available on impact of poor wastewater management ?
- Previous initiatives – what can they tell us about what works and what does not work ?



Following Up

- Programmes to change attitudes and practices
- Changes to implement management practices
- Proposals for physical changes
- Evaluation



Six Principles

We need to develop a strategic plan based on the following six principles:

Principle 1 : Take a wide view of sanitation

Principle 2 : Involve all stakeholders

Principle 3 : Respond to demand of users

Principle 4 : Develop sound finances to be able to provide, operate and maintain the facility

Principle 5 : Develop incentives for good practice

Principle 6 : Take manageable steps towards intermediate objectives
