- ♦ Eliminate villages surveyed in GTZ/ BASED report (Analysis of farming systems in selected areas of the Northern Province) i.e. Tshikonelo and Tshaulu and others where projects are currently happening.
- ♦ List all towns and villages according to maps in the Northern, Lowveld and Southern Districts into two groups, those further than 10-15 km from major towns or major roads, and those closer to these infrastructures.
- Select randomly two villages (as first choice and stand-by) in each category from this list.
