

Consent to certain actions for the purposes of the Initial Enforcement Order made by the Competition and Markets Authority (CMA) on 11 January 2017

Completed acquisition by Intercontinental Exchange, Inc. (ICE) of Trayport

I am writing to you in response to your e-mail of 27 January and our subsequent correspondence.

The CMA consents to Trayport moving its data centre from its former owner's inhouse data centre to a third party data centre. For the avoidance of doubt, a third party is defined as a party that is not ICE. The CMA gives its consent on the basis that ICE will not be involved in any negotiations with third party data centre providers and the Monitoring Trustee continues to be kept informed by Trayport on the progress of the negotiations.
