## **JUDGMENT**

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is as follows:-

1. The Respondent breached the Claimant's contract of employment by failing to pay him notice pay.
2. The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £254.65 net as damages for breach of contract.
3. The Respondent made unauthorised deductions of £158.48 from the Claimant's wages contrary to section 13 Employment Rights Act 1996.
4. Accordingly, the total the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant under this judgment is £413.13
