JUDGMENT

1. By consent the Claimant's claim that he suffered an unlawful deduction from wages, a failure to pay accrued annual leave and that he suffered breach of contract succeed. The agreed award to the Claimant in respect of those claims is £3,716.33 and the Claimant has judgment for that sum.
2. The Respondent has failed to establish its employers contract claim and that claim is dismissed.
3. Costs order is made in favour of the Claimant in relation to Tribunal fees paid in this case amounting to £390.

Accordingly the total sum due from the Defendant to the Claimant is

£4,106.33.
