- 1. The respondent breached the contract of the claimant by failing to give proper notice of dismissal and the claimant is awarded damages in the sum of £245.51.
- 2. The respondent failed to make a proper payment to the claimant representing holiday accrued and untaken and is directed to pay him £4.00.
- 3. The respondent made unauthorized deductions from the wages of the claimant and is directed to pay the claimant £4,243.68.
