## **JUDGMENT**

# REASONS

- 1 On 13<sup>th</sup> March 2017 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 27<sup>th</sup> March 2017 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- 2 The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
