## DEFAULT JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

In default of the Respondent presenting a response within the relevant time limit, and having regard to rule 21 Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013, the judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- The Respondent has failed to comply with a requirement of sections 188 and 188A of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992. The claim for a protective award succeeds.
- (ii) The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimants remuneration for a protected period of 90 days beginning on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2016.
- (iii) The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimants a further £1,500 being the Claimants issue fee pursuant to Rules 75(1) (b) and 76(4) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013
