

Notice of intention to release undertakings given by Badgerline Holdings Limited pursuant to section 88 of the Fair Trading Act 1973

- In October 1989, the Secretary of State accepted undertakings from Badgerline Holdings Ltd (Badgerline) (now FirstGroup plc) following an investigation by the Monopolies and Mergers Commission (MMC) into Badgerline's acquisition of Midland Red West Holdings Ltd. The MMC's report on the investigation was published in March 1989.¹ The undertakings were amended in February 1996.
- 2. The Competition and Markets Authority (CMA) has a statutory duty to keep under review undertakings given under the Fair Trading Act 1973.² On 30 January 2017, the CMA announced its intention to review the undertakings given by FirstGroup plc.
- 3. On 9 June 2017, the CMA published its report entitled *Review of FirstGroup bus undertakings in Bristol Provisional decision*. For the reasons given in that report, the CMA has provisionally concluded that FirstGroup plc should be released from the undertakings.
- 4. The CMA now gives notice of its intention to release FirstGroup plc from the undertakings.
