## JUDGMENT

The complaints of unfair dismissal and for a redundancy payment are struck out.

## REASONS

1. By letters dated **28 April 2017** and **9 May 2017** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of unfair dismissal and for a redundancy payment should not be struck out because

- The claimant lacks the qualifying two years' service to present such claims.

2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaints of unfair dismissal and for a redundancy payment are therefore struck out.

3. The claimant's remaining claims remain listed for hearing on 5 September 2017.
