JUDGMENT

- 1. The claims of Mr Green relating to unfair dismissal and disability discrimination are all struck out for want of jurisdiction.

All claims were made out of time and in relation to the unfair dismissal it was reasonably practicable for the claimant to make his claim in time, and with regard to the claims under the Equality Act 2010 relating to the protected characteristic of disability, it is not just and equitable to extend time.
