# JUDGMENT

The Claimant's application dated 27<sup>th</sup> June 2017 for reconsideration of the judgement sent to the parties on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2017 is refused.

## REASONS

There is no reasonable prospect of the original decision being varied or revoked, because the Claimant as a Manager would, and should have known how to apply for expenses incurred during the course of his employment. If he was unsure or unable for any reason then he should have raised this with his Line Manager or the HR Department. The fact of the matter is the Claimant never did raise any issue over his expenses or the claiming of this in the course of his employment, save those in June, July and August 2016 when the Claimant had no access to his computer.
