REMEDYJUDGMENT

My Judgment is that:-

- 1. The Claimant is entitled to a basic award of £2,874.
- 2. The Claimant is awarded the sum of £27,132 by way of compensatory award.

- 4. The basic and compensatory awards will be paid by the Respondent to the Claimant forthwith.

- 1. The Claimant's application for costs in relation to the liability hearing and today is declined.
- 2.
